
Hello to the Scouts and Leaders of the 2nd Section!

Pioneering/Constructions

Each **Scout group** will have to build:

- a table for meals
- a kitchen
- a shaded area
- a recycling bin

What to bring?

Individual supplies

Each element:

Uniform;

Comfortable clothing (shorts, t-shirts, underwear, socks) Reflective vest:





Sunscreen (biodegradable);

Appropriate footwear for walking and showering;

Plastic container with lid (aka Tupperware) and cutlery (for meals on the go);

Hat/Cap;

Reusable water bottle/ flask;

Camping gear (sleeping bag, hygiene kit, etc)

Insect repellent

Individual napkin (sustainability challenge)

2 white t-shirts (for leaders also)

For nautical activities:

- Footwear for activities in the water (water shoes or old but light sneakers, flip flops won't do);
- Swimsuit/swim shorts:
- T-shirt:
- A change of clothes and a water bottle inside a small backpack;
- Towel:

For Adventure Camp:

- Clothing and shoes that can get wet and dirty sneakers, bathing suit, t-shirt;
- A small backpack for a change of clothes and a water bottle.

Scout group supplies

- Tents:
- Camping and cooking equipment (pay attention to the conditions and expiration date of the stove hose);
- Firefighting equipment 1 fire extinguisher per group of 5 tents and 1 kitchen + 2 buckets of sand OR 1 fire blanket for the kitchen
- Awnings and/or shade nets;
- Plant/ herb (sustainability challenge)
- supplies for the recycling bin (sustainability challenge)

Patrol supplies

- Patrol flag/ banner (if you have one);
- Notebook and pen;
- First aid kit.

Individual challenge


CLOTH NAPKIN


You'll need:

- Old t shirt or piece of fabric (45x45 cm)
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Sewing thread
- Paint/ decoration

Step 1 - cut a 45x45 cm square







Step 3 - decorate as you wish





Group challenge 1



AROMA CORNER

Gather your Scout Patrol/ Group and grow a plant/aromatic herb from your country.

Bring it to Acanac and get to know all plants and herbs at **Aroma Corner** and use them to cook your meals, which will be a lot tastier.

How should I grow my plant?

You'll need:

- seeds:
- soil with natural fertilizer;
- water:
- empty egg carton;
- **Step 1** Put some soil in the egg carton.
- **Step 2** Using your finger, make a 1 cm deep hole in the soil.
- **Step 3** put 2 or 3 seeds in each hole.
- **Step 4** cover them with more soil, but don't make it compact.
- **Step 5** water the plant.









How to prepare natural fertilizer?


1 - egg shell

If you want to use them as a fertilizer, egg shells should be crushed in a blender or with a mortar and pestle until they're transformed into a powder. You can sprinkle the powder over the soil, which will cause the calcium to be absorbed as you water the plant.

2 - coffee grounds

To use coffee grounds as a fertilizer, you first have to dilute them in water. You can use roughly 100 gr/ 3 tablespoons of coffee groups with 1L of water and you'll need to wait one week until this solution is ready to be used. You can then put it in a watering can








3 - Cinnamon

You can mix powdered cinnamon in the soil to prevent fungal infections on the plants and to accelerate their rooting.

Group challenge 2

Recycling bin

We challenge you and your scout group to build a recycling bin, so you can separate the waste you'll create while on camp. Get to work and let your imagination run wild!



Rules you should follow:

- 1 You have to build the recycling bin, using wood and rope.
- 2 The recycling bin must have at least 4 compartments (one for plastic, one for paper, one for glass and one for organic waste).
- 3 The recycling bin should not be bigger than 32x29x50 cm.

What should and shouldn't I put in each recycling bin?





Yellow - Plastic and metallic packaging

Should put in: water, juice, food oil and detergent bottles, plastic bags, butter and milk packages, food cans, yogurt cups, styrofoam and spray bottles

Shouldn't put in: batteries, CDs and DVDs, gasoline, paint or varnish bottles, non-package plastic, organic residues, glass

Remember to drain and flatten the packages and reuse your bags

Blue - paper and cardboard packaging

Should put in: flattened paper and cardboard packages, newspapers, magazines, toilet paper rolls, paper bags, publicity leaflets and flyers

Shouldn't put in: stickers, laminated paper, aluminum foil, absorbent paper, paper/cardboard with grease, dirty tissues or napkins, baby wipes, diapers, cement bags.

Remember to flatten the packages and prevent the paper from getting wet or contaminated

Green - glass packaging

Should put in: glass bottles and jars

Shouldn't put in: light bulbs, drinking cups, plates, porcelain and mirrors.

Remember to drain the packages, remove any metal rings and avoid depositing glass at late hours to prevent disturbing your neighbors

Organic residues

Should put in: vegetable and fruit peels, bread, pasta, tea bags, leaves, stems, grass, flowers, wood chips, ashes

Shouldn't put in: batteries, glass, plastic, medication, animal stools, fats, dairy, meat, fish or seafood

WHAT CAN I DO TO ADOPT A MORE ECO-FRIENDLY BEHAVIOR?

Always remember that our founder Lord Baden Powell advised us to leave the world a little better than we found it. It seems hard, but #vaicomcoragem (go for it)!



Here are some tips for you to follow if you truly want to be an Eco-Scout:



- Use a luffa sponge Luffa is a plant that can be dried and used as a sponge. It's 100% biodegradable.
- 2) Prefer a reusable bag On average a plastic bag takes between 100 and 400 years to decompose.
- 3) Avoid single use plastics Use your water bottle or flask, your glass and cutlery. Single use plastics are bad for the environment.
- **4)** Choose solid shampoo A single shampoo bar is equivalent to two bottles of liquid shampoo. An additional plus is that this way you're not producing plastic waste.
- 5) Save water Use a glass to brush your teeth, do the dishes in a bowl or bucket and not in running water and when you're showering remember to turn off the water when you're using the soap.

Did you know that by 2040 Portugal is thought to face a serious water shortage? If everyone had the same lifestyle as the Portuguese, we would need two planets Earth to accommodate our need for resources.
