

PORTUGUESE NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE 2022

Regulation



Article 1

DEFINITION, ACTIVITIES AND PURPOSES

- a) The Portuguese NSA – Corpo Nacional de Escutas (CNE) promotes, for Cubs/Beavers, Scouts, Explorers and Rovers/Network, from august 1st to august 7th 2022, the 24th Nacional Scout Jamboree (hereinafter referred to as Acanac22). Its motto being “Builders of tomorrow”.
- b) Acanac22 aims to:
 - Be, from its preparation to completion, a benchmark in scouting for each person, providing them a range of learning opportunities, as well as a contribution to their own personal progression.
 - Create the opportunity to consolidate the Scouting Movement as a way of promoting sustainable development with an impact on our community(ies);
 - Provide individual and collective learning opportunities that meet the ambitions set down by this generation of young people (2000-2012) as the builders of the Acanac22.
 - Promote a sense of belonging to the CNE, initiating the CNE Centenary celebrations with a camping activity that brings together all regions of our country.
 - Promote the cultural exchange between people from different backgrounds (local, regional and global).
 - Affirm CNE as a youth movement of reference in education, sustainability and community service.

Article 2

ORGANIZATION

- a) Acanac22 will take place at CNAE - Centro Nacional de Atividades Escutistas (Idanha-a-Nova National Scout Centre), in Idanha-a-Nova, as well as in other places nearby, in the region of Portalegre e Castelo Branco.
- b) The campsite will be divided into 5 camps:
 - Cub Scouts (6-10 yo);
 - Scouts (10-14 yo);
 - Venture Scouts / Explorers (14-18 yo);
 - Rovers / Network (18-22 yo);
 - Staff / Service Team



- c) Check in will take place from 9 a.m. to 11 p.m. on the 31st of July and from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the 1st of August. Checkout will take place on the 7th of August, until 4 p.m..
- d) The International Service Team (IST) should check in until 10 a.m. of the 30th of July and checkout after 4 p.m. on the 8th of August.
- e) The maximum number of participants in Acanac22 is 17.000 (seventeen thousand) scouts.

Article 3

PARTICIPATION TERMS

- a) The participants should have their Scout Promise until the 30th of June, 2022.
- b) All IST participants, as well as other Scout Leaders, need to have successfully completed their training on “Safe from Harm - Acanac” before checking in.

Article 4

INTERNATIONAL SCOUTS

All international scouts that wish to be a part of Acanac2022 must be between 10 and 22 years old, and will be able to make their registration on the Acanac22 Website, between the 1st of February and the 31st of March 2022, paying the event fees stated in Article 5.

- a) Each international contingent will have a host/translator from the moment they arrive at Lisbon or Porto airports and during their trip to the campsite, as well as on their way back on the 7th of August.
- b) International scouts should be organized by their national contingents in patrols/groups and choose the section closer to their age on the registration form.
- c) International scouts wishing to be a part of the staff team (IST) should be at least 18 years old by the time Acanac22 begins and must apply until the 30th of April 2022.
- d) International scouts must have valid insurance with their NSO.



Article 5

PARTICIPATION FEES

- a) Participation fee for international scouts will be 250 euros.
- b) Registration in Acanac22 includes the activity badge, a necker and a woggle, access to all activities and all the meals between dinner on the 1st of august and breakfast on the 7th of august. Participants will also be given a packed lunch on the last day.
- c) For the adult participants working with the IST, meals for the extra service days will also be provided.
- d) In case of cancellation, a percentage of the registration fee will be refunded, according to the undertakings made by the CNE until the cancellation moment.

Article 6

CAMPSITE LIFE

- a) In addition to the general activities (Opening Ceremony, Holy Communion and Closing Ceremony), activities within sections/units campsites will be promoted, as well as activities for the staff campsite.
- b) Leaving the campsite will not be allowed without a written authorization from Section Campsite Leader or Campsite Leader.
- c) Acanac22 Campsite Guidelines will be a part of the Acanac22 guidebook.

Article 7

FINAL PROVISIONS

- a) By enrolling in Acanac22, participants authorize the processing of their voice and/or image data collected during the Acanac and relinquish their rights to it to CNE for 5 years, free of charge and without the need of a previous consultation on how to use this data. CNE comites to always act in good faith and in accordance with its Law and Principles. The data will be used to gather information for the historical archive and to advertise new projects, events and activities promoted and/or organized by CNE in different ways, i.e. posters, leaflets, exclusive CNE merchandising products, social networks, website, television, radio, among other formats.
- b) Disciplinary issues will be handled according to the Scout Method, and their resolution will ultimately be up to the Acanac22 Campsite Leader.
- c) Campsite functioning will obey the organization chart described on the Campsite guidebook.
- d) Omitted situations on this Regulation will be up to the Campsite Leader.
